CLASS INFORMATION

Steps to enroll in our program include:

- (1) **A criminal history free of convictions for any felonies or misdemeanors.** Please go to the website: mycb.castlebranch.com/. Look for **"Place Order"** in upper right hand corner. In the Package Code box, enter package code: **MI30**. After reading the disclaimer statement click the small box to accept. Click **"Continue Order"**. Complete required information. Select a method of payment: Visa, MasterCard or money order. The cost is \$40 (subject to change). Once your order is submitted, you will receive a password via email to view the results of your background check. The results will be available in approximately 48-72 hours. **Please have this completed before you come to register.** This way you will have access to the results and be able to determine if you want to take this class at this time.
- (2) **High School Diploma -OR- G.E.D**
- (3) **Current listing with no findings, on the N.C. Nurse Aide Registry**
- (4) **Current American Heart Health Care Provider C.P.R. card (cards from any other agency are unacceptable).**

To progress and successfully complete the program students are required to have:

- (5) A drug screen that is **negative**. A date and time will be arranged for students to report for a drug screen after the classes begin. The cost of the test will be the student's responsibility. We have an arrangement with a local healthcare provider to do these tests. The current charge is \$20-\$40 (price subject to change). The hospitals want this done 2-3 weeks before you begin clinical. **Do not do this on your own.** The time and location will be announced after you begin the class.
- (6) A verified Record of Immunizations/MD physical. Information is included in the paperwork received the day you register for the class. Please bring your record or complete as many of the required immunizations as possible and be prepared to present proof on the first day of class. All immunizations/MD physical requirements must be met within 45 calendar days from the first day of class (32 days for 6 hour classes). There are NO exceptions to this policy. Failure to comply will mean **immediate** dismissal from the program.
- (7) A proper Federal or State photo ID.

Registration:

Upon registration you must present proof of items 1-4 for verification. **Once verification is complete**, you can register/pay. Registration is completed at the Continuing Education Center cashier's office located at 701 W. Front Street, Statesville. Classes have limited seating. Seats will not be held and are filled on a first qualified, first served basis. For more information on class availability, please give Mrs. Chambers a call at 704-878-4311. The criminal background checks are usually good for 1 year for our facilities. This is subject to change by our host facility policies. The facilities will determine if the drug screen has to be up-dated.

Class Information & Expenses:

All Nursing Assistant II classes at Mitchell Community College are 182 hours: 94 hours of classroom/lab instruction and 88 hours of clinical experience. Clinical dates may involve some Saturdays and several eight hour classes. Nursing Assistant classes follow a very strict attendance policy.

Expected expenses: (prices are subject to change)

Criminal Background Check--\$40.00-(**DO NOT** use another company other than Certified Background)

Drug Screen—approximately--\$20-\$40.00-(Facility **will only accept** their own)

Immunizations/MD physical—cost will vary with the individual's history-**IMPORTANT**-required immunizations & physical must be complete on or before 45 calendar days (32 calendar days for 6 hour classes) from the first day of class.-**NO EXCEPTIONS-students who do not comply will be dismissed from the program.**

IMMUNIZATIONS & PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

North Carolina law, as well as Mitchell Community College's clinical sites, requires all Nursing Assistant students be properly immunized.

Mitchell Community College and the clinical facility host requires each student to have a physical to show that he/she is physically able to perform skills and procedures related to patient care in the clinical setting without restrictions.

Students must understand that he/she must show proof of immunization or immunity for the following diseases along with proof of physical on or before **45 calendar days** (32 calendar days for 6 hour classes) from the first day of class:

Tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis (Tdap)

Influenza-optional unless required by hospital

Poliomyelitis-required for individuals 18 or younger

MMR- total of 2 if required

Varicella-total of 2 if required

2 step PPD-

Hep B or waiver

MD physical-students must have clearance from a physician to participate in lab and clinical activities. Form provided.

It is **very strongly** recommended that students start immediately gathering proof of **OR** receive required vaccinations/titers prior to the first day of class and be prepared to present proof for as many of the required immunizations listed above as possible on the first day of class.

WARNING !

Any student that fails to provide proof of COMPLETED immunizations or immunity & physical on or before 45 calendar days from the first day of class (32 calendar days for 6 hour classes) will be immediately dismissed from the Nursing Assistant Program. There will be NO exception to this policy.
